GORDON GRANGER/SALLY ROGERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline: Postmark by Monday, May 2, 2011

Award: \$2,000 for one Hawaii Island Public High School Senior, or \$1,000 for each of two Hawaii Island Public High School Seniors, depending on the number of quality applications submitted

Eligibility: The student must be a graduating senior from a public high school on the Island of Hawaii. Applicants should have plans to attend college and to major in one of the life sciences (animal science, biology, botany, environmental science, marine science, pre-veterinary medicine, zoology, etc.), with intent to pursue a career focused on improving the well-being of wild animals in some significant way.

Applications will be considered based on the clarity of the student's vision of his/her goals, on the likelihood of reaching those goals, and on the need for financial support in pursuing them.

Application Procedure: Please submit, **in one packet**, the following materials, *Postmarked by Monday, May 2, 2011:*

1. a completed application form
2. a resume, or a listing of your interests, achievements, and work experience, both paid and volunteer
3. an official high school transcript
4. a personal essay describing your interest in studying a life science and your plans to improve the well-being of wild animals for your career. (This essay should be written entirely by the applicant and should not exceed 2 pages in length.)
5. a brief statement (1-2 paragraphs) of your need for financial assistance and how a scholarship would help you achieve your goals
6. two letters of recommendation written by individuals who are familiar with your character and accomplishments, but who are not related to you, placed in sealed envelopes, signed across the seal

4. a statement of need for financial assistance
5. two letters of recommendation, in sealed envelopes, signed across seal
